The energy crisis was at the heart of a speech given by Elisabeth Borne this afternoon. The Prime Minister made an inventory of our energy capacities in anticipation of this winter. The tone was more about awareness than fear, as she explained that we will avoid cuts as long as we observe energy conservancy.

And the government will launch an energy conservancy awareness campaign next month.

In this context, the rise in energy prices will be limited to 15% in 2023, thanks to the tariff shield. According to Elisabeth Borne, energy bills will increase by an average of 25 euros per month for households heated with gas, instead of 200 euros without the tariff shield. For electricity the increase will be 20 euros per month instead of 180 without this measure.

The prefecture of Gironde orders the preventive evacuation of 500 new people in the Médoc as over 3,600 hectares have burned down since Monday in the sector of Saumos. Hundreds of firefighters are still mobilized.

British flags, dozens of royal guards, and the respect of an entire people for their sovereign: The royal procession accompanied the coffin of Elizabeth II in London this afternoon from Buckingham Palace to Westminster. The coffin was surrounded by King Charles III, William the Prince of Wales and his brother Harry. Cannon shots were fired in the capital in tribute to the Queen.
