In London, thousands of people are gathered in front of Westminster Abbey where the coffin of Queen Elisabeth II will remain until Sunday. In the crowd, many anonymous people but also some personalities such as David Beckham.

Emmanuel Macron will meet with King Charles III Sunday in the United Kingdom. The French president will attend a reception that will be given at Buckingham Palace with other leaders. A trip on the eve of the funeral of Queen Elizabeth II, which Pope Francis will not attend as announced today by the Vatican.

In France, if you have a flight scheduled for today, you will have to be patient. Air traffic is very disrupted due to a strike by air traffic controllers. They are demanding higher wages and more manpower. As a result, more than 1,000 flights have been canceled, which is about half of all scheduled flights.

Unity and making their voices heard by the opposition are the two main challenges of the parliamentary days of the *Rassemblement National* which began today in Cap d'Agde. RN MPs will meet until Sunday and the upcoming election of the party's new president is approaching. Jordan Bardella and Louis Alliot are candidates to succeed Marine Le Pen. The votes will be open at the end of September. Results are expected on November 5 during the 18th congress of the party.

The Versailles prosecutor's office has requested the provisional detention of Aminata Diallo. The former PSG player is directly implicated in the attack on her former teammate Kheira Hamraoui. On November 4, 2021, she was beaten with iron bars by two men in the presence of Aminata Diallo. A sporting rivalry between the two players seems to be at the heart of this case.

And then basketball tonight with the Semi-final of the Men's Euro. Les Bleus face Poland for a place in the final. The game begins at 5:15.
