They demonstrated to demand better wages as they face inflation. At least 200 gathering took place throughout France at the call of unions. The protesters also denounce the pension reform wanted by the government.

And this pension reform could lead Emmanuel Macron to dissolve the National Assembly. The Head of State says he is ready to resort to dissolution in the event of a vote of no confidence against the government. This scenario is obviously favored by Mathilde Panot - The president of the *Insoumis* in the National Assembly addressed Emmanuel Macron directly on Twitter, posting the following: "When you want: the Nupes is ready to defeat you ".

The mayor of Metz is hospitalized following a small stroke. François Grosdidier, himself, announced it on Twitter, ensuring that he had no after-effects. He will remain hospitalized for a few days to take undergo further examinations. Today's municipal council was therefore be held without him.

Russia will ratify tomorrow the annexation of the territories it controls in Ukraine. This is announced by the Russian presidency. According to the Kremlin spokesman, the treaties will be signed with the four territories where referendum annexations took place. A few minutes ago, in a speech, Vladimir Putin considered that the West was in the process of collapsing.

On the front, the Ukrainian city of Dnipro was the target of a Russian strike today, killing at least four people. Among the victims were two children aged 8 and 9. A 12-year-old girl was also rescued from the rubble.

And also abroad, more than two million homes are still without electricity in Florida after the passage of Hurricane Ian. The weather phenomenon caused considerable damage. Twenty people are missing.

And to finish: it's a first since 2015, births have started to rise again last year in France. More than 740,000 babies were recorded, which is an increase of 0.9% over one year.
