The end of strike in refineries is not for now. After having met the management of *TotalEnergies*, the CGT does not want to end the movement. The management continues to refuse a 10% increase of wages, but they ask that the strikers unblock the stocks of fuel in storage to relieve the tension in gas stations. An inter-union meeting will be organized this evening to decide on the continuation of the movement. *Force Ouvrière* has announced that it is joining the strike at six refineries, including the sites of Donges, La Mède and Grandpuits.

Things are off to a bad start for the budget review. The National Assembly immediately rejected the article which plans to limit the public deficit to 5% of GDP in 2023. At the end of the Council of Ministers, the spokesman Olivier Véran confirmed that the government does not reject the idea of using the 49.3 to pass the budget if it is blocked.

Almost two years after the disappearance of Delphine Jubillar, a reconstruction will take place next month in the couple's house, in the Tarn. It was the lawyers of Delphine's husband, Cédric Jubillar, who asked for the organization of this reconstruction. Indicted for the murder of his wife, the suspect has been in detention for almost a year and a half and has always claimed his innocence in court.

Beware of bronchiolitis: Four regions are in the epidemic phase of this disease which affects babies. Ile-de-France, Hauts-de-France, Nouvelle Aquitaine and Occitanie. According to *Santé Public France*, the rest of the territory will soon be affected as well.

More than 100 people are charged in Iran as demonstrations continue in the country. The movement was originally triggered by the death of a 22-year-old young woman, arrested by the morality police. The gatherings are qualified as riots by Iranian authorities.
