The CGT is meeting this evening to decide on the future of the movement. On strike for three weeks, the employees want a 10% wage increase. The situation seems to be improving in gas stations: According to Prime Minister Elisabeth Borne, less than 25% of gas stations are experiencing supply difficulties today, against 28% yesterday.

Meanwhile, thousands of people were in the streets today to demand better wages. According to the CGT, nearly 150 gathering points have been set up throughout France for this interprofessional mobilization. Some tensions were reported in the Parisian procession, where a bank branch was degraded in the 14th arrondissement.

Lola's parents were received by Emmanuel Macron at the Elysée. The Head of State presented his condolences to them and assured them of all his solidarity and support. The body of the 12-year-old teenager was found in a trunk by her building in the 19th arrondissement of Paris. Meanwhile, the main suspect, indicted, was placed in solitary confinement in the prison of Fresnes.

And Cédric Jubillar remains in detention. His sixth request for release was refused by the Toulouse Court of Appeal. Cédric Jubillar is indicted for the murder of his wife Delphine, who has been missing for almost two years.
