Marine Le Pen says that Emmanuel Macron "refuses to play the democratic game". The leader of the RN MPs defends her motion of censure against the government, after the use of the *quarante-neuf trois* article of the constitution for the budget. She also announces that her group will vote for the motion submitted by the Nupes. However, mathematically speaking, the two groups do not have enough MPs to bring down the government of Elisabeth Borne.

Lola's funeral took place this afternoon in Lilère, in the Pas-de-Calais, ten days after the murder of the 12-year-old girl, whose body was found in a trunk. Hundreds of people were present to support the family, including the minister of the Interior Gérald Darmanin.

As the supply of gas stations is improving day by day, prices at the pump are starting to drop once again. Last week, on average, the liter of diesel lost 1.6 cents, and that of gasoline 3.3 cents. Despite this downward trend, significant differences remain depending on the region.

Rishi Sunak becomes the new British Prime Minister. The former finance minister of Boris Johnson succeeds Liz Truss after a mandate of only 44 days. Rishi Sunak will have the mission to revive the United Kingdom, mired in a severe economic and social crisis. This is the first time that the country will be governed by a man of Indian origin.

Russia implies that Ukraine is acquiring nuclear weapons. According to the Russian Defense Ministry, the development of a "dirty bomb" by Kiev has entered its "final phase". These allegations are rejected by the Ukrainian government. The Minister of Foreign Affairs asked the International Atomic Energy Agency to send experts to Ukrainian facilities to prove Russia's lies.

And then in soccer, the Brest club supports, in a press release, its player Islam Slimani. The striker accuses the captain of Clermont of racist insults, yesterday, during the match between the two teams. Johan Gastien, refutes these accusations altogether. the *Stade Brestois* asks the Disciplinary Commission to shed light on these events.
