The Secretary of State for Ecology will present this afternoon a plan to better supervise the practice of hunting in order to avoid accidents. The measures that will be submitted include an alcohol offense similar to that applied in the highway code, or a ban on hunting on Sunday afternoons. These measures still have to be negotiated with the federations of hunters.

Also in the news, a deceased policeman and several people injured, including one seriously last night on the A13 in the Eure. A heavyweight mowed down several vehicles, including those of law enforcement and patrol officers who were on the emergency lane.

The rental of housing categorized as bad energy performance housing will soon be banned on AirBnb. The Minister for Housing, Olivier Klein, announced this morning on BFM Business that he wanted to extend the law prohibiting the rental of accommodation classified F and G by the energy performance diagnosis to furnished tourist accommodations. The measure will come into force in 2023.

In the United Kingdom, Rishi Sunak met with King Charles 3 this morning. The 42-year-old former banker will officially be appointed British Prime Minister following the resignation of Liz Truss. Of Indian origin, Rishi Sunak will thus become the youngest, but also the richest head of state in British history.

And seven civilians were killed yesterday in Bakhmout, in the Donetsk region of Ukraine. The city has been targeted for several months by the Russian army. Ukraine announces that it took over four villages from Russian forces yesterday in the north-east of the country. German President Frank-Walter Steinmeier arrived in Kiev this morning for a surprise meeting with President Volodymyr Zelensky.
