The body of Justine was found early this afternoon in Corrèze. It was found at the location indicated by the main suspect, very close to his home in the town of Beynat. The man confessed while in police custody. The 21-year-old farm worker admitted to having killed and buried the 20-year-old young woman but did not give any explanation so far. Justine had not given any sign of life since Sunday while at a nightclub in Brive. The public prosecutor of Limoges is to hold a press conference on this case at 6.30 p.m.

New measures of help from the government were communicated in the midst of the energy crisis. Prime Minister Elisabeth Borne unveiled this afternoon 3 measures for businesses, especially for small and medium-sized businesses excluded from the tariff shield. A part of their bill will be paid for by the State. This measure will also concern communities, associations, hospitals and universities. In total, 12 billion euros will be injected.

And they continue the movement. The strike is reconducted at the TotalEnergies refinery in Gonfreville in Seine Maritime. The mobilization will last until November 2 - date of a new general assembly. Employees are still asking for wage increases while TotalEnergies published record results today. 6.5 billion euros of profits were reported in the third quarter of this year.

Also in the news: Elon Musk published a press release this evening to explain why he wanted to buy Twitter. His objective is to make the social network a healthy platform for debate, without resorting to violence. The transaction is expected to be finalized tomorrow for approximately \$44 billion.

And then a start in the Spanish Basque Country, 30 climbs over three weeks and a final on the Champs Elysées in Paris. This is the program for the *Tour de France* 2023 which will start on July 1st. It was unveiled today by the race director Christian Prudhomme. The peloton will also return to the top of the Puy de Dôme summit after 35 years.
