This the end of a long soap opera: Elon Musk finally buys Twitter for 44 billion dollars. The founder of Tesla immediately dismissed three leaders of the social network. The richest man in the world promises to relax content moderation, raising fears of a possible resurgence of misinformation on the platform.

Also in the news, the Minister of Health François Braun speaks this morning of a "hostage taking situation". He denounces the actions of certain laboratories, which since yesterday, have suspended the transmission of COVID-19 test results to the *Assurance Maladie*. Professionals are contesting the 2023 social security draft budget. The budget provides for 250 million euros of savings of per year on the work of biologists.

In the Eure, a 21-year-old heavyweight driver was indicted yesterday for homicide and involuntary injuries. He is suspected of having fatally mowed down a gendarme on the A13 highway last Tuesday. The gendarme was trying to stop two suspected drug traffickers.

And a forest fire is still active in Cap Corse. 450 hectares have gone up in smoke since last Sunday in this double fire. However, firefighters say the incident is now under control.

In Ukraine, the International Atomic Energy Agency is visiting to two sites at the request of Kiev. The IAEA has announced that it is verifying the accusations of the Russian president. Vladimir Putin believes that Ukraine is preparing a "dirty bomb" made of radioactive materials.

And new ballistic missiles were launched from North Korea. This was announced by the South Korean military this morning amid fears of another nuclear test from Pyongyang.

To finish: A find described as major by NASA: the American space agency declared last night that it had discovered a meteorite impact on Mars. 152 meters wide, it is the largest crater ever observed on the red planet. The shock occurred last December.
