It's an unexpected message of encouragement: That of the former Russian president to Elon Musk. Dimitri Medvedev wishes the billionaire good luck after his takeover of Twitter... And he asks him to stop supporting Ukraine. Since the beginning of the war, Elon Musk has had 25,000 terminals delivered to Ukrainian authorities via his company SpaceX in order to maintain an internet connection in the country.

Meanwhile, the partial mobilization of 300,000 Russian soldiers is over. This was announced by the Kremlin after an appeal launched a month ago by the Russian President. 80,000 people have already been sent to the front while others are still in training. They will have to support the Russian army which is currently encountering major difficulties against the Ukrainian forces in the north-east of the country.

In France, the improvement was short-lived. After two months of slowdown, inflation has accelerated in October in France, with a 6.2% increase over one year according to the INSEE. This is simply unheard of since 1985.

A vast drug trafficking network has been dismantled in several French departments. The operation was carried out in Bouches-du-Rhône, Alpes-Maritimes, Haut-Rhin, Jura and Côte d'Or and led to the seizure of 90 kg of cannabis resin, 13 kg of cocaine, weapons and nearly 130,000 euros in cash. In total, 22 people were arrested, 5 of which remain in custody. They are suspected of having organized a large network of imports from Morocco and Belgium.

And a vast plan to fight forest fires was unveiled today by Emmanuel Macron. After a summer ravaged by fires, the Head of State has decided to strengthen the measures to prevent them. A budget of 150 million additional euros will be paid to all the emergency services. A billion trees will also be planted within ten years in France, which is equivalent to 10% of our forests, as promised Emmanuel Macron.
