Pediatric professionals and the Minister of Health will be Meeting today. François Braun will receive caregivers to work on the future of the sector but also on the future of hospitals in general. As a reminder, more than 4,000 of them signed an open letter at the end of last week to warn of the saturation of pediatric hospital services. In Ile de France for example, more than thirty children have been transported outside the region, following the bronchiolitis epidemic which affects the country.

A nuclear bill will be presented today to the Council of Ministers. Its objective is to accelerate the construction of new reactors while simplifying the various necessary administrative procedures. This bill may then be discussed in Parliament early next year.

It was quite simply the hottest month of October ever recorded in France since 1945 and the beginning of measurements by the Météo France organization. The average temperature in France last month was 3 to 4 degrees above normal. Monthly records exceeding 32 degrees have also been beaten in Corsica and in the south-west of the territory.
