The MP of the *Rassemblement National* Grégoire de Fournas is sanctioned by the National Assembly. He receives a temporary 15-day exclusion from the Assemby and he will also be deprived for 2 months and a half of his parliamentary allowance. This is the heaviest sanction provided for by the regulations. As a reminder, Grégoire de Fournas pronounced a polemical sentence yesterday in the National Assembly during a question on exiles asked by the black MP of Nupes Carlos Martens Bilongo. The elected RN official had then hurled "he should go back to Africa".

This is a decision that could once again spark things off: The department of Vienne has validated a vast project of 30 giant water reserves by 2026. These famous mega basins will have the capacity to store nearly 9 million cubic meters. This is much more than in the neighboring department, that of Deux-Sèvres, where a similar project in Sainte-Soline provoked an outcry from environmental activists last weekend.

And all of France is affected, but it is a in Ile de France that the Bronchiolitis epidemic is accelerating the fastest. Pediatric services are under great tension. As a result, 35 children had to be transferred to other regions to be treated according to the ARS. For now, the white plan has not yet been activated in the Paris region even if the number of patients has been sharply increasing for a month.

And large retailers are concerned as the shelves of hypermarkets and supermarkets continue to empty little by little. The phenomenon was accentuated in October according to an analysis firm. Fresh products and groceries are the most affected. This situation is due to delivery difficulties caused by the fuel crisis of these past weeks but also the war in Ukraine.
