In his speech, just now, during the COP27 in Egypt, Emmanuel Macron says he wants to stay on course with the Paris agreements. He added the following: "The climate emergency is here, it is not for tomorrow". 110 Heads of State and Government are gathered for this COP27. In opening, the Secretary General of the UN Antonio Guterres did not mince his words, proclaiming that: "We are on the highway to climatic hell, with our foot on the accelerator".

11 bishops or former bishops are implicated in cases of sexual abuse, as announced by the president of the conference of bishops of France. They are targeted by either civil justice or the justice of the Church following reports. Among these personalities is Monseigneur Ricard, former bishop of Bordeaux, who admitted "reprehensible" conduct on a minor 35 years ago.

The search continues in Savoie to find two young mountaineers who have disappeared since Saturday evening in the massif of Vanoise. A helicopter is trying to find these two 25-year-old skiers who were attempting to climb a high peak.

The property tax will increase in Paris. Mayor Anne Hidalgo, faced with a delicate budgetary situation, goes back on her campaign promise not to raise these taxes. Next year, the property tax rate will rise from 13.5% to 20.5%, except for owners who undertake the thermal renovation of their apartment and those encountering economic difficulties.

Good news for the French soccer team: According to the newspaper *l'Equipe*, Raphael Varane will be physically fit to compete in the World Cup in Qatar. The defender of *les Bleus* was injured at the end of October, but his rehabilitation is progressing well. Didier Deschamps will announce his list of players on Wednesday.
