Gérald Darmanin describes Italy's attitude towards the Ocean Viking as "unacceptable". Italian authorities have refused to welcome the boat carrying more than 230 migrants. "Italy is not measuring up to its humanitarian duty", deplores the Minister of the Interior, who announces retaliatory measures. The Ocean Viking will finally be able to berth tomorrow in Toulon.

Public transportation was very complicated in Paris today. Metros are barely circulating, and traffic is difficult on the RER. Unsa-RATP says that it is ready for an indefinite strike next week regarding wages. The CGT has organized between 150 and 200 demonstrations to ask for better wages. In Paris, the demonstration started from the *Place de la Republic* going in the direction of *Place de l'Opera*.

About thirty scientists demonstrated today in front of the headquarters of Dassault Aviation in Paris. They denounce the environmental consequences of private jets. The demonstration is part of a coordinated action in ten different countries.

Poultry farmers are on alert: The Ministry of Agriculture warns of a high risk of an avian flu epidemic throughout France. This level of alert implies the automatic confinement of the animals concerned. Poultry kept by individuals must also be monitored and kept in enclosed spaces. More than 21 million poultry were slaughtered in 2021-2022 season.

And to finish, a priest is indicted and imprisoned for "aggravated rape" of a 15-year-old teenager. The events date back to last week in Paris. The priest is also accused of having drugged his victim after meeting him on an application. In police custody, the priest who officiates in the diocese of Rennes, explained that he did not know that the young man was a minor.
