A tribute was paid to Lola and organized this afternoon in Paris, a month after the death of the 12-year-old girl whose body was found in a suitcase. The victim's family, relatives and friends walked through the 19th arrondissement. Lola's parents wanted this tribute to be calm, far from political and media agitation. In this case, the main suspect was indicted for murder and aggravated rape then placed in pre-trial detention.

The former Archbishop of Strasbourg recognizes "inappropriate gestures". Monsignor Jean-Pierre Grallet, now retired, is under a canonical investigation for "serious events against a young adult woman" in 1985. The court was seized a few months ago.

"There is no indication of a deliberate attack in Poland". These are the words of the head of NATO, the day after the death of two people following a missile which landed on Polish soil. Preliminary analysis suggests the incident was likely caused by a Ukrainian anti-aircraft missile. In which case it would be a missile fired by Ukraine to defend itself against Russian strikes. Ukraine requests an immediate access on site.

A little earlier today, Emmanuel Macron spoke at the G20. He once again pleaded for negotiations regarding the situation in Ukraine and assures that France will continue discussions with Russia. Emmanuel Macron wants China to have a greater role in the mediation. The Head of State said he had discussed with Chinese President Xi Jinping a possible visit to China in early 2023.

the Route du Rhum sailing race is mourning the deaths of two people in a follower boat accident on arrival in Pointe-à-Pitre. A judicial investigation has been opened for involuntary homicides. In the competition, it is Charles Caudrelier who won. The French skipper crossed the finish line after 6 days and 19 hours of race, which is a record. Charles Caudrelier led the race practically from the start to finish and finished ahead of François Gabart.

And then in tennis, Novak Djokovic won against Andrey Rublev this afternoon at the Turin Masters. The Serb secures his place in the semi-finals.
