Fuel prices are improving, despite the reduction in discounts. Last week a liter of diesel cost 1 euro and 86 cents and that of Unleaded 1 euro 72. Rates fairly close to those noted at the end of August, before the introduction of the 30 cents aid granted by the State.

Caroline Cayeux leaves her post as Minister Delegate in charge of Local Authorities. Her declaration of assets has been deemed "undervalued". In a press release, Caroline Cayeux explains that the High Authority persists in questioning her sincerity. She therefore prefers to resign so as not to hinder the action of the government. It is her colleague in charge of Rurality, Dominique Faure, who replaces her.

The bill examined from today in the National Assembly aims at punishing squatters more severely. The text, carried by the groups of the presidential majority Renaissance and Horizons, proposes to triple the penalties incurred by squatters. The penalty could then reach up to 3 years in prison and a 45,000-euro fine. The MPs of *La France Insoumise*, communists and environmentalists are up against the text. They believe that this law wants to criminalize unpaid rent.

Facebook's parent company, Meta, is sentenced to 265 million euros for not having sufficiently protected the data of its European users. Facebook had been the victim in 2019 of a hack which had affected 530 million users and the hacked data was then found on a hacker forum.
