There will be no power outage on Monday in France, despite the cold spell. The Ecowatt measure remains green, according to the network manager, RTE. There will be enough electricity despite a possible peak in consumption related to heating. Nevertheless, RTE calls on the French to continue to be careful. For Monday and all of next week, RTE is expecting a temperature drop of 5 to 6 degrees compared to the reference temperatures.

"Anyone can get a booster vaccine", clarifies the Minister of Health François Braun, as some pharmacists refuse to vaccinate those under 60. If all French people are eligible for a booster, the most fragile are obviously encouraged in priority to get vaccinated. François Braun is about to hold a press conference and he will also address the issue of masks in transportation.
