The pension bill will have to wait. The text, which was originally to be presented on Thursday, will finally be presented on January 10. This was announced by Emmanuel Macron earlier today at the opening of the second plenary session of the National Council for Refoundation.

The pension reform will perhaps be voted by the Republicans, but under certain conditions, according to the new - freshly elected - head of the party, Eric Ciotti. He wants the new system to take into account the difficulty of each profession. Eric Ciotti intends to influence the debates by submitting amendments in the National Assembly, as in the Senate.

After three months of debate, today is the last day of hearing at the trial of the attack of Nice. It was the defendants who spoke this morning. Eight, in total, are being judged, three for criminal terrorist conspiracy. The National Anti-Terrorist Prosecutor's Office has requested 15 years in prison against them. The Paris Special Circuit Court is now deliberating. The hearing will resume tomorrow at 5 p.m., for the announcement of the verdict. The Nice attack had killed 86 people on July 14, 2016.

Josep Borrell evokes "serious and very worrying accusations". The head of European diplomacy reacts to the scandal surrounding Eva Kaili, the Greek vice-president of the European Parliament, who is indicted for corruption and money laundering. Eva Kaili is suspected of having received money from Qatar to influence her decisions. 600,000 euros in cash were found at her home.

And a new tragedy took place in Qatar: A second journalist died during the World Cup, a few days after the death of an American reporter. It is now a Qatari photographer who suddenly died. We do not yet know the exact circumstances of his death.

And then the cold wave is not sparing the United Kingdom, which is under the snow. Many flights have had to be canceled these past hours in London. According to the BBC, more than 50 flights were canceled at the Heathrow airport, the most important of the British capital, because of the freezing fog.
