The French team will play against Argentina in the final of the soccer world cup!!!! *Les Bleus* beat Morocco 2 to 0 yesterday in the semifinal. Théo Hernandez scored in the 5th minute and Randal Kolo Mouani in the 79th, only 44 seconds after coming into play. A victory celebrated by Emmanuel Macron, who was present yesterday in the stands in Qatar.

And Emmanuel Macron will be present in the stadium again on Sunday to support Les Bleus in the World Cup final. It will be against the team of Lionel Messi - Argentina - on Sunday at 4 p.m.

In France, the victory was celebrated in Paris Marseille and Toulouse. Thousands of supporters celebrated in a largely good-natured atmosphere with only some incidents. At least 115 people were arrested in the Paris region.
