Two men were arrested this morning in the Montparnasse train station in Paris. They were in possession of 9 small gas canisters and threatened to blow everything up according to the first elements collected. No firing system was found on the devices. The suspects were taken into custody for vindication of terrorism.

After Japan, Italy, the United States and Spain, this time it is Israel's turn to impose health measures against the coronavirus on travelers from China. The country is currently affected by an outbreak of cases of contamination since the abandonment at the beginning of the month of its highly contested Zero Covid policy. France may also announce this weekend strengthened controls at airports.

It's a big disappointment for the 122 former employees of several ArcelorMittal factories. The industrial court has just rejected their request filed for anxiety damage. Exposed for several years to asbestos, they had requested 15,000 EUROS each to have the courts recognize their fear of falling ill.

Météo France even speaks of the warmest New Year's Eve ever observed across the country since the beginning of surveys more than 70 years ago. Temperatures will even reach 17 degrees in Corsica - This ends a year that was marked by many climatic phenomena, in particular a record heat wave this summer.
