The Russian ceasefire will begin in a few hours. Moscow has called for a truce from noon, given Orthodox Christmas is celebrated this weekend. For Kyiv, it is a maneuver to stop the advance of the Ukrainian army in the Donbass.

Unable to convince The House, Kevin McCarthy has not been elected as a new speaker. There is still no speaker in the United States House of Representatives after 3 days and 11 rounds of voting. This has become the longest speaker contest in 164 years.

Emanuel Macron has faced boulangerie employees, who were received at the Elysée Palace yesterday during the traditional Epiphany ceremony. The President of the Republic calls for the renegotiation of electricity contracts.

Emmanuel Macron is going to a hospital in Corbeil Essonne today to meet its exhausted staff, saturated services, and lack of resources. The health system is on the verge of collapse. The President of the Republic has promised a major overhaul and will reveal the main points this morning.

Manuel Bompard has been officially appointed as the new boss of La France insoumise, an appointment decided unanimously by the party leadership. The deputy explained that he would probably continue this task, which he has been performing since the withdrawal of Adrien Quatennens, who was convicted of domestic violence.

His health is improving. Damar Hamlin, the American footballer who suffered a heart attack during a match a few days ago is better. Still in critical condition, he is making steady progress according to the medical team following him. The match between the Buffalo Bills and the Cincinnati Bengals, which had been suspended, will not be replayed following this accident.
