Six people were stabbed at Gare du Nord in Paris. The attack took place early this morning, shortly before 7 a.m. The assailant was arrested by the police and is in critical condition after being shot in the chest. An investigation has been opened to determine the identity of the attacker and his motivations. For the time being, the anti-terrorist department is not involved.

After the presentation of the pension reform, the Medef welcomes "the pragmatic and responsible decisions" taken by the government. The employers' organization insists on the need to work longer.
