





The company Place du Marché, ex-Toupargel is put into a compulsory liquidation. The former French leader in the delivery of frozen products counted up to a million customers in its heyday but it has gone into bankruptcy several years ago. This liquidation leads to the loss of 1,900 jobs.

The secretary general of the CGT Philippe Martinez wants the mobilization of millions of people on January 19 for a strike against the pension reform.
