45,000 households are still without electricity this evening in the west of the country, mostly in Normandy. Traffic at the SNCF was also disrupted until the beginning of the afternoon. A 62-year-old driver was killed in Gironde after hitting a tree that had just fallen on the road in Saint-Mariens near Bordeaux.

In addition, 5 departments are placed under orange alert this evening: Landes and Pyrénées Atlantiques for rain and flooding. Cantal and Lozère for snow and black ice. And then Pas de Calais for floods.

A tragic event took place in the Val de Marne, where a 16-year-old teenager was stabbed to death this morning in front of a high school in Thiais. Another young man was seriously injured but he is out of danger. A minor who may be the assailant was arrested. An investigation is underway, said the prosecutor of Créteil who mentioned that everything points to an ambush.

The 200 employees of Go Sport will still have to wait. After a hearing today, the Grenoble Commercial Court reserves its decision for Thursday concerning the future of the company. Go Sport may be insolvent. The group that bought the company in 2021 is optimistic, which is not the case of the unions, who are worried and fear to suffer the same fate as Camaïeux. Both companies have the same owner.

In Ukraine, the European Union denounces a war crime in Dnipro. The city was hit this weekend by Russian bombings, killing at least 40 people and injuring 75 more. A residential building was targeted. Emergency units were deployed on site to help the victims. Moscow, however, denies being at the origin of this deadly attack.

And then the men's handball world championships: 2 wins in 2 games for the French team and maybe a 3rd tonight against Slovenia. The French team is already qualified for the rest of the competition. Tonight's game begins at 6.
