The Social Affairs Committee still has more than 5,500 amendments on the pension reform to examine. It began this morning, and will continue its work until Wednesday evening, at the latest. The reform will be examined in a week at the Assembly.

In the meantime, we are preparing for a second big day of mobilization against the text tomorrow. 1 out of 2 teachers will be on strike according to the first elementary school union. As for transportation, Air France cancels one in ten flights but long-haul flights will be spared. At the SNCF, only 1 train out of 3 will circulate on average on the TGV and Ouigo network and two TER out of ten will be insured.

A solemn march is organized on Sunday in Epinal In tribute to Lucas, a 13-year-old teenager who ended his life in the Vosges in early January after being harassed at school. The mother of the victim believes that the school should have taken stronger measures to protect her son, such as disciplinary sanctions against students suspected of having uttered mockery and homophobic insults. A trial will be held in the spring.

How can we effectively fight discrimination in France? The government's plan was presented today with 80 measures, including the organization of a historical visit for each student linked to racism or anti-Semitism. In addition, the filing of complaints by victims will be facilitated by allowing complaints to be lodged directly at the headquarters of certain associations.

Fuel prices continue to rise in France. We now must pay, on average, 1 euro 94 for a litter of diesel and 1 euro 91 for unleaded. An increase in prices that occurs while the government rebate is no longer in force at the pump. From now on, a fuel check of 100 euros is paid to the most modest households.

And then a birth on the rails: yesterday, on a train from Paris to Strasbourg, a pregnant woman began to feel contractions. So that she could give birth in complete serenity, the train was stopped and the firefighters intervened. The young woman gave birth to a baby boy, both are doing well.
