Many questions remain this evening regarding the death of Sihem in the Gard. The 18-year-old young woman whose body was found in a forest last night. A week after her disappearance, the main suspect, a 39-year-old man already sentenced by the court, confessed. He explained to the investigators that an argument had broken out between him and Sihem, an argument regarding their romantic relationship. However, according to the lawyer of the victim's family, Sihem's relatives had no knowledge of such a relationship.

In any case Sihem knew the main suspect well, since it is the ex-boyfriend of her cousin. The high school student was babysitting the couple's children.

Different strategies are being considered to fight the pension reform. This is what emerged from the meeting that took place today between the various SNCF unions. The CGT, UNSA, Sud rail and CFDT are all calling for a strike next Tuesday, but only SUD rail and the CGT wish to continue the strike on Wednesday.
