Total Energy made record profits last year with 19 billion euros. This is the biggest profit in its history. But the French oil giant is not the only one to report exceptional profit. For Laurent Horvath, energy geo-economist, it is the entire sector that recorded record profits in 2022. These companies have also benefited from the explosion in gas prices, with margins that have not changed, which are 6 to 8 times the purchase price.

In the rest of the news, hundreds of tractors are in Paris. Farmers are demonstrating today in the capital to make their anger heard. They deplore too many administrative constraints and restrictions on the use of pesticides after the ban on neonicotinoids.

And a hard blow for the shoe brand André: The group that owns the company has been placed in receivership by the Nanterre commercial court. A hearing is scheduled for the end of March to decide whether or not the brand's activity should cease.

Abroad, Volodymyr Zelensky is expected today in the United Kingdom. the Ukrainian President is going to London to meet British Prime Minister Rishi Sunak. This is his second trip to abroad since the beginning of the Russian invasion a year ago. The United Kingdom is expected to announce new military aid to Kyiv as well as training for fighter pilots.
