A body that was found charred today in a forest in Finistère may be Héléna, the student who has been missing for 10 days in Brittany. Examinations will soon take place to identify the victim. The suspect in this case is a 36-year-old Brestois who died today. He had been in a coma for a few days, after having attempted suicide.

This is a record sanction: the C8 television channel was today fined 3.5 million euros by Arcom. This follows the comments and insults of the host Cyril Hanouna towards the LFI MP Louis Boyard during the program Touche Pas à Mon Poste on November 10. The media regulator considers that these remarks violate the rights of the guest, disrespect for his honour and his reputation.

After the elderly, should children be vaccinated against the flu? The High Authority for Health recommended today this vaccine to ALL children aged 2 to 17 years old. Until now, the recommendation was mainly aimed at people at risk over 65 years old.

Volodymyr Zelensky is still in Brussels this evening. The Ukrainian president meets the king of the Belgians after his visit to the European Council. During the day the leader gave a speech in which he said he was very grateful for the European aid to his country in the face of the Russian invasion. He once again called on the leaders of the European Union to speed up arms deliveries for Ukraine.

And we remain abroad where the number of deaths in Turkey and Syria continues to grow. Over 20,000 deaths are now recorded this evening after the major earthquake that hit the region Monday morning. France announced the release of 12 million euros for the victims in Syria.
