They have 4 days to examine 14,000 amendments. The debates on the pension reform must end on Friday in the Assembly, and the MPs are still examining article 2 devoted to the "senior index". There are still several amendments before the long-awaited article 7, which pushes back the retirement age to 64.

The review of the reform will begin in two weeks in the Senate, after a week of parliamentary break.
