Five days after his serious road accident, Pierre Palmade was placed in police custody. His state of health no longer causes concern, and he can now be questioned by investigators. The objective is to get a better idea of the circumstances of the tragedy. The analyzes show that the comedian had consumed cocaine before driving. Pierre Palmade was transferred to the hospital of Melun for a police custody which can last up to 48 hours.

After the discovery of a dismembered body in Paris, at the Buttes-Chaumont, the investigation is progressing. We now know the identity of the victim thanks to her fingerprints. She is a 46-year-old woman who lived in Seine-Saint-Denis. She had been missing since the beginning of the month. A murder investigation has been opened.

The Aix-en-Provence prosecutor's office is indicting a couple of young parents after the death of their 8-month-old baby. They are suspected of abuse. The child was in a coma when he arrived at the Timone hospital in Marseille, and he presented serious injuries. The couple, who lives in Martigues, contests the allegations.

The government is not abandoning, in the end, article 2 of the pension reform; the one on the senior index that was rejected by the MPs last night. The measure is supposed to help fight unemployment among older workers. At the end of the Council of Ministers, the government spokesman, Olivier Véran, regretted this rejection.

And the red letter struggles to seduce the French. It was supposed to replace the red stamp since January 1, with a digital version. La Poste indicates that it is only used 3,500 times a day, which is too little. The service is not sustainable if the number of daily shipments does not increase to at least 5,000.
