300,000 demonstrators were in Paris to protest the pension reform, according to the CGT. The number of demonstrators has decreased since the last day of mobilization. The union had then reported 500,000 demonstrators in the capital and the authorities 93,000.

And high school and student organizations are calling for the mobilization of the younger generations on March 9. They want the movement to grow with regular mobilizations.

In the National Assembly, time is running out, the debates on the pension reform will end tomorrow evening at midnight. To speed up the examination of the bill, the Nupes has decided to withdraw 90% of its amendments, up until in article 7 - The article that provides for the change of the legal age of retirement.

Pierre Palmade claims to have very few memories of his road accident. His police custody for homicide and involuntary injuries has been extended, just like that of the first passenger arrested. The comedian admitted to having taken drugs. He had tested positive for cocaine.

And a tragedy took place in the Hautes-Pyrénées, where base-jumper died after jumping from a cliff and falling over 30 meters lower. The CRS of the mountain rescue team had been searching for the 44-year-old man. He supposedly made several errors during his jump.

This is a first in Europe: Spain is creating menstrual leave for women suffering from painful menstruation. The leave must be authorized by a doctor and will be financed by Social Security. The People's Party, the main right-wing opposition force, warns against a risk of stigmatization and the negative impact for women on the job market.
