





What will the judge decide? Pierre Palmade may be indicted for "homicide and involuntary injuries", after the serious accident he caused, a week ago, in Seine-et-Marne. His placement in pre-trial detention was requested. The two passengers in his car were also brought before the investigating magistrate for "failure to assist a person in danger".

As for the mobilization against the pension reform, the CGT calls for a renewable strike in refineries from March 6, to continue to put pressure on the government. According to the union, the movement could be of the same magnitude than that of last October, when the strike against wages had dried up the gas stations. The CGT wishes to participate in "a popular uprising against the reform".

During this time the examination of the text enters its final stages. The MPs are looking into the reform until this evening, midnight. After that, the bill will go to the Senate. At the rate at which the debates advance, it is unlikely that MPs will have the time to examine article 7 which enacts the postponement of the legal age of retirement. There are still thousands of amendments to be studied.

A ceremony is organized this afternoon in Haute-Vienne to pay tribute to Robert Hébrass, the last survivor of the Oradour-sur-Glane massacre, who died last Saturday at the age of 97. The Minister of National Education Pap Ndiaye will be present at the ceremony. On June 10, 1944 the village of Oradour-sur-Glane was destroyed by the Nazi forces, who killed more than 600 people.

"It is very clear that today is not the time for dialogue", said Emmanuel Macron regarding Ukraine, during an intervention before the Conference on Security in Munich. According to the Head of State, Russia "cannot and should not win this war". He calls on Europe to intensify its support for Ukraine and to move towards "credible negotiations". As for the Ukrainian President, Volodymyr Zelensky calls on allies to step up support for his country.
