Inflation reached 12% in 2022 on food products. This is revealed in the report published today by Familles Rurales. And it comes as no surprise that the Inflation is the most difficult for low-income households. To help them, the association is asking the government for a monthly aid of 65 euros for 9 million households.

The cost of the measure is estimated at 7 billion euros, which is however a lower investment compared to the 20 billion euros spent to treat pathologies linked to malnutrition according to the association.

In the rest of the news, a high school teacher from of Saint-Jean-de-Luz was stabbed this morning. The teacher is in critical condition according to the Bayonne prosecutor. The circumstances of the attack remain unclear. Apparently a student entered the class before stabbing him several times. The student was arrested.

And it was expected: A historic but sad record has now been broken. France has just experienced 32 consecutive days without significant rain. The situation is concerning, especially in the winter - A season during which groundwater is usually renewed.

The UN General Assembly will discuss Ukraine today, 2 days before the 1-year anniversary of the beginning of the Russian invasion. The draft resolution to end the conflict will be voted. The text demands in particular the immediate withdrawal of Russian forces.
