3 months after the mysterious disappearance of Leslie and Kévin in Deux-Sèvres, a man was arrested this morning in Vendée. The suspect is a 20-year-old relative of the young couple. He is currently questioned as part of the assisted witness procedure. In this case, 22-year-old Leslie and 21-year-old Kevin, have not given any sign of life since November 25, after an evening at a friend's house, near Niort.

The Pension Reform arrives today in committee at the Senate. The text will be examined by the Senators from 2:30 p.m. before the opening of the debates on Thursday. The SNCF unions are all calling for a renewable strike from next Tuesday.

Doctors' unions are also very upset. Negotiations with Health Insurance end this evening, and no agreement has been reached on the consultation fee. In the absence of an agreement, the new agreement will be drawn up by a referee, who will present the text in 3 months.

And the state is after the papillomavirus. Emmanuel Macron is expected today in a middle school of Jarnac in Charente where he will "make a decisive announcement to eradicate this disease responsible for thousands of cancers each year. A disease that can be eradicated through screening and vaccination, but the vaccination coverage is still too low in France, with only 37% of girls and 9% of boys vaccinated.

It's the end of the game for Noel Le Graet. The president of the French Football Federation is expected announce his resignation as the head of the FFF at the end of an executive committee which is currently being held. Noel Le Graet has already withdrawn on January 11 after being accused of harassment and following his many controversial remarks.

And then soccer again, but on the field this time: The quarter-finals of the Coupe de France start tonight. Lyon receives Grenoble. Kick-off at 9:10 p.m.
