The campaign will be generalized in middle schools at the start of the next school year. All volunteer students from 5th grade will be able to get vaccinated against the Papillomavirus. The virus is responsible each year for more than 6,000 new cases of cancer in France. This was announced this afternoon by Emmanuel Macron from a middle school in Jarnac, Charente.
