A football legend is gone. Just Fontaine yesterday in Toulouse at the age of 89. Iconic striker of the 50s and 60s, Just Fontaine is a big name in French soccer.

Everyone in the world of soccer pays tribute to him today. PSG, TFC and of course the Stade de Reims sent a message on their social networks in memory of former player.

In the rest of the news, Gap France is placed in receivership. The decision was made by the Grenoble commercial court. The ready-to-wear brand has 20 stores and around 350 employees throughout France.
