MPs will not get much rest. After busy weeks discussing the pension reform, elected officials will have to take a position on Monday on the motions of censure submitted by the RN and the LIOT group following the use of article 49.3 yesterday by the Prime minister. And it is again the Republicans who could tip the scales. Some have already announced that they would support one of the motions; others allow themselves time for reflection.
