Charles III will not be coming to France. The British sovereign was expected in Paris on Sunday but the tense context linked to the demonstrations against the pension reform has changed the plan. According to the Elysée, the decision was made by the French and British governments, after an exchange between Emmanuel Macron and the King. A new visit will be organized as soon as possible, indicates Buckingham Palace.

The fight against the pension reform was marked by violence and degradations yesterdays. In particular in Paris, Bordeaux, Rennes and even Lorient. Nationally 441 police officers and gendarmes were injured according to the Minister of the interior Gérald Darmanin who points the finger at far-left groups. 457 people were arrested.

Meanwhile, the garbage collectors' strike continues in Paris. 10,000 tons of waste are not collected. On the other hand, the situation in waste treatment sites is improving. This morning 3 out of the 4 sites were open.

The government is prohibiting recreational applications on the phones of French civil servants. In particular Tik Tok. According to the Ministry of Public Service, these applications present risks in terms of cybersecurity and data protection of public officials. The ban comes into force today.

Bruno Le Maire unveils his plan for influencers. The Minister of the Economy is clear: He wants to fight excesses and abuses. For instance, in terms of placement of fraudulent products and services. In addition to a stricter framework, Bercy has also unveiled a "guide to good conduct" intended for social network personalities. This guide contains the essentials of their rights and duties.
