Here we go again for new day of mobilization against the pension reform. The 10th since the start of the protest. Up to 900,000 people are expected in the streets, with in particular many young people. They could be 2 to 3 times more than last week to oppose the text.

As for the head of the CFDT, he directly challenges the government. Laurent Berger asks to put on hold the postponement of the legal age of retirement at 64. He also calls for mediation to try to find a way out of the conflict. The request will be made in writing to Emmanuel Macron, said Philippe Martinez of the CGT.

And the National Assembly is attacking the market of influencers. A law will be studied today to better regulate their activity and limit misbehaviours by imposing a framework for promotions on social networks. Among the measures submitted, is the prohibition of the promotion of cosmetic surgery procedures as well as the incentive to invest in cryptocurrencies.

The United States is in shock, once again, after this new bloody shooting in an elementary school. It happened yesterday in Nashville. 6 people were killed, including 3 children. The assailant was a former student of the establishment and was shot dead by authorities. The American President Joe Biden has once again called on Congress to change the gun laws.

And then good news for the French economy. The public deficit shows a sharp decline in 2022 and now stands at 4.7% of GDP. The figures were communicated by the INSEE.
