Will the dialogue resume around the pension reform? The unions will be received by Prime Minister Elizabeth Borne at the beginning of next week at Matignon. In appearance, the government is extending a hand of friendship, but in reality, it may not be that clear. Whatever happens during this meeting, there will be an 11th day of mobilization against the text. The intersyndicale is again calling for a strike and a demonstration next week, Thursday, April 6.

In the rest of the news, an investigation has been opened for assassination after this double homicide in Rennes last night. Two men were shot dead in the popular district of Maurepas. A heavily armed individual opened fire on a group of young people. The two victims were aged 29 and 35.

Abroad, the director of the International Atomic Energy Agency is expected at the Zaporijia power plant. He calls for a protection zone around the site, which is regularly targeted by Russian strikes. It is Rafael Grossi's second visit to Zaporijia - the largest nuclear power plant in Europe,
