One year after the contaminated Buitoni pizza scandal, Nestlé announces that the Caudry factory in the North will shut down. The group is committed to looking for a buyer for the site, which has been closed since the beginning of the month. The 113 employees will be offered a solution. The health scandal of contaminated pizzas has caused the death of two children.

Emmanuel Macron is in the Hautes-Alpes, in Savines-le-Lac to present the government's water plan. The objective is to respond to the drought affecting France and adapt to global warming. Some fifty measures are planned to reduce waste and better manage water resources. A resource which, according to experts, should decrease by 10 to 40% over the next few decades.

And this trip of Emmanuel Macron is under close surveillance. Dozens of trade unionists from the CGT and Force Ouvrière are mobilized to challenge the president on the pension reform. The presidential procession passed through the boos of demonstrators, who were pushed back by the police.

A call for a rally is launched by several environmental groups, in particular "Les Soulèvements de la Terre". Gatherings are this evening at 7 p.m. in front of the prefectures to support the wounded in Sainte-Soline, as two demonstrators opposed to the mega-basin project are still in a coma. According to the Ministry of the Interior, between 16,000 and 20,000 people from ultra-left collectives have planned to gather this evening.

The Vatican communicated that Pope Francis has had a good night. The 86-year-old sovereign pontiff has been hospitalized since yesterday in Rome for a respiratory infection. He is expected to stay hospitalized for several days. However, the Pope should be able to preside over Palm Sunday Mass at the Vatican.

And then it's only a matter of hours. The French Football Federation will appoint Hervé Renard coach of the French women's team this afternoon, after the departure of Corinne Diacre. Hervé Renard, who has never coached for women, has been at Lille, Sochaux and Zambia in particular and he was until now the head coach of Saudi Arabia.
