The citizens' convention supports active assistance in dying, and is in favor of assisted suicide. This opinion was delivered yesterday after 3 months of debate on the legalization of euthanasia. The citizens' convention brings together 184 French people selected randomly by lot. Some will be received this morning at the Elysée by President Emmanuel Macron. The Head of State will speak after this meeting at the end of the morning.

A decisive week for the government around the pension reform. Elisabeth Borne will continue the discussions in the coming days with the leaders of several political parties and the unions before the new day of mobilizations on Thursday. The objective is to ease tensions and find a way out in this social crisis. The Prime Minister will today receive the group at the LIOT Assembly, who had tabled a motion of censure against the reform.

The mayor of Paris Anne Hidalgo welcomes the results of the citizens' consultation. And the results are clear. Nearly 90% of Parisians voted yesterday AGAINST self-service electric two-wheelers in Paris. These scooters will therefore disappear from the capital from the start of the next school year. The vote was marked, however, by the low turnout. Only 7.46% of Parisians turned out to vote.

A firefighter has been knocked down in Bordeaux after being mobilized for a fire in the night from Friday to Saturday. He had asked the driver to wait before being able to circulate. The motorist refused to wait and hit the firefighter. The driver fled, the firefighter, slightly injured in the ankle, will file a complaint.
