The question of the end of life is one of the big projects of Emmanuel Macron's five-year term. The members of the citizens' convention, who have worked for more than 3 months on the subject, said they were in favor yesterday of euthanasia. And after having consulted this citizens' convention, the president spoke a few minutes ago from the Elysée.

However, the Ordre des Médecins says it is not in favor of its participation in euthanasia.
