There will be a bill before the end of the summer. This was announced today by Emmanuel Macron on the debate around end-of-life care. The head of State spoke this morning from the Elysée after the conclusions submitted yesterday by the citizens' convention. After 4 months of debate around this very controversial subject, the council is in favor of euthanasia and assisted suicide in France.

She promises to be attentive on all subjects. Elisabeth Borne began her week of consultations today to try to ease tensions regarding the pension reform. The Prime Minister received this afternoon centrist parliamentarians and members of the Liot group in the assembly who had submitted a motion of censure against the text. Wednesday there will be a one-on-one discussion between Elisabeth Borne and the inter-union. The new head of the CGT, Sylvie Binet, has already expressed that she asks for the reform to be withdrawn otherwise Wednesday's meeting risks being cut short.

There is still no trace of the two Spanish hikers missing in the Pyrénées-Orientales. They had left on Saturday to climb the Carlit peak. The two men had to spend the night in the forest at an altitude of more than 2500m, with freezing temperatures reaching minus 25 degrees. They have managed to contact emergency services who have not been able to locate them so far. The search continues despite very difficult weather conditions, including very strong gusts of wind.

In Paris, it's almost a return to normal. Waste collection has resumed for several days after the end of the garbage collectors' strike against the pension reform. Yesterday there were 650 tons of trash left to pick up on the sidewalks of the capital. This is 10 times less than in the middle of the crisis.

And to finish, NASA will unveil its new team for the Artemis 2 mission this evening. 4 astronauts will be selected to circumnavigate the Moon aboard the Orion spacecraft next year. The launch date of Artemis 2 is currently scheduled for November 2024. The flight should last about ten days.
