More than 48 hours after a building collapsed rue Tivoli in Marseille, acts of solidarity are organized by the relatives of the victims and even the inhabitants evacuated from neighbouring buildings. The collective of November 5 requested that the 200 evacuees be relocated in requisitioned Airbnbs. And searches continue, as 6 people were found dead and two other are still missing.

Pap Ndiaye announced new measures this morning to fight school bullying. The Minister of Education wishes in particular to facilitate the exclusion of bullying students, without the opinion of the mayors and "independently of the opinion parents". However, he clarified that such a measure would only be put in place as a "last resort".

And Elisabeth Borne receives Marine Le Pen today at Matignon. The pension reform will once again be discussed. Tomorrow local elected officials are invited, before a new day of mobilization on Thursday. And especially before the decision of the Constitutional Council on Friday which will have to say whether or not the text complies with the Constitution.

In the meantime, Gérald Darmanin is in Gironde today. The Minister of the Interior is expected at Teste-de-Buch, where major fires broke out last summer. He will unveil his long-awaited Plan to fight forest fires.

And to finish: Will Adrien Quatennens reintegrate the *Insoumis*? The question is debated this morning during a meeting of the group at the National Assembly. As a reminder, the elected official was expelled from *la France Insoumise* after a 4-month suspended prison sentence for domestic violence.
