Search operations continue in Marseille after a building collapsed last weekend. A tragedy that caused 6 deaths. 4 of the victims have been identified. The identification unit is once again at work to determine the identity of the other victims. 2 other people are still missing. As for the investigation, a gas leak seems to be the cause. A gas meter on the first floor was recovered from the rubble and is currently being exploited.

And this tragedy led to the evacuation of many residents. A little over 200 people are still homeless. Some were able to access their apartment in order to collect their belongings, others cannot return in their homes because the buildings are too fragile.

And Gérald Darmanin is in Gironde this evening. The Minister of the Interior is expected in particular at Teste-de-Buch, where large fires broke out last summer. He will participate alongside the Minister of Ecological Transition Christophe Béchu and the Minister of agriculture Marc Fesneau in a ceremony honoring those who helped fight the flames. Gérald Darmanin will also present the plan to fight forest fires. La Teste de Buch was devastated last year by fires that burned about 7 thousand hectares.

India will become the most populous country in the world by the end of April, according to UN estimates. We cannot say precisely when this will occur because the last Indian census, which was to take place in 2020, was not done due to Covid. But it is a certainty: China is seeing its population decrease, while the number of Indians continues to rise.

And the Beauval Zoo Pandas will stay until 2027. The Zoo Parc du Loir et Cher has made it official, the loan of Yuan Zi and Huan Huan, who arrived in France more than 10 years ago, has been extended. Their little Yuan MENG, born in 2017, should soon leave the park. He will be repatriated to China to breed with other pandas and thus ensure the conservation of this endangered species.
