Up to 600,000 people are expected in the streets tomorrow for a new day of mobilization against the pension reform. The 12th since the start of the protest. 270 demonstrations are planned throughout France with blockades and disruptions in several sectors such as energy and transportation. Unions want to keep up the pressure before a new decisive step on Friday and the long-awaited opinion of the Constitutional Council on the validity of the text.

Also in the news, Gérard Depardieu is accused of sexual assault. No less than thirteen women agreed to testify in a long investigation published by the Mediapart site. They claim to have been touched, sexually abused or victims of inappropriate behavior by the actor during various shoots. The events were supposedly minimized each time by the production team. As a reminder, Gérard Depardieu is already indicted for a rape and sexual assault on a young actress in the summer of 2018.

Also in the news, a 22-year-old woman was fatally stabbed last night in Tours. She received 14 stab wounds and her father is the main suspect. He was arrested and placed in police custody in a hospital because of his psychological state. An investigation for intentional homicide has been opened.

In soccer: His reaction was not long in coming. In a press release sent to AFP by his lawyer, PSG coach Christophe Galtier very strongly disputes the accusations against him. The former director of OGC Nice Julien Fournier says Christophe Galtier made racist and discriminatory remarks last season, as he was coaching the team of Nice. Legal proceedings are to come to denounce these insulting and defamatory remarks, said Christophe Galtier's lawyer.

And then all the fans were impatiently waiting. Celine Dion will unveil new songs tomorrow. The songs were recorded for the film *Love again, un peu, beaucoup, passionnément,* which is a romantic comedy scheduled for release in the month of June in which the singer plays her own role. This is reassuring news, as the 55-year-old Canadian artist had to cancel part of her tour this year for health reasons.
