The decision is imminent. The Constitutional Council will publish its decision on the pension reform any minute. They can validate the text totally partially or reject it. They must also decide on the shared initiative referendum.

And a few hours before this deadline, Elisabeth Borne was visiting a supermarket in Eure et Loire - A complicated trip for the Prime Minister who was welcomed by demonstrators, but this was relativized by Elisabeth Borne.

On the side lines of this trip Elisabeth Borne announced that the minimum wage will increase by just over 2% in May.

Emmanuel Macron is already thinking about him after. The Elysée indicates that the Head of State has invited the unions to come and meet with him next Tuesday. According to Emmanuel Macron's entourage, it is to show that the door of the Elysée is open without the precondition of dialogue. It remains to be seen if the trade unions will accept the invitation.

Also in the news, last night in Savoie, three mountaineers were found dead after an avalanche near Tignes. The victims are aspiring Italian guides who were accompanied by a professional guide. Only the instructor was able to get out to call for help.

And this time the Juice mission was launched after a false start yesterday. This was a successful launch for the European mission in charge of exploring Jupiter and its icy moons. The objective is to check if these moons are potentially liveable as the scientists suppose. The trip will last 8 years.
