They intend to be heard this evening in hundreds of cities in France. In Paris, Lyon, Toulouse, Renne, Lorient, Bordeaux or Strasbourg, opponents of the pension reform will organize pot concerts at 8pm. Gatherings are planned in the streets or in front of town halls at the call of the association ATTAC, la France Insoumise and the union Solidaires. Sounds of pots and pans have already accompanied this afternoon the trip of the Minister of Health François Braun at the University Hospital of Poitiers.

And François Braun will be tomorrow in the Loir et Cher to accompany Emmanuel Macron. The President will be in Vendôme. He will visit the university multidisciplinary health center to talk with the nursing staff. This will include discussing their working conditions and issues regarding recruitment, training and access to care.

The hostage-taking situation has ended in Vienne. The man who had been holding 4 people hostage since this morning in a house located in Quinçay, near Poitiers was arrested. The prefecture had mentioned earlier today that the man is a former detainee who was just released from prison. According to the first elements of the investigation, the possibility of a terrorist act is ruled out. The privileged thesis is that of a family conflict.

In Mayotte, Operation Wuambushu has started. Nearly 2,000 police and gendarmes are deployed by the Ministry of the Interior in this French department located in the Indian Ocean. The objective is to destroy slums and dislodge undocumented migrants in order to deport them to the Comoros - their country of origin for the most part. However, the Comorian authorities have already refused this afternoon the docking of a boat carrying migrants from Mayotte.
