Emmanuel Macron is traveling to Vendôme in the Loir et Cher this afternoon. A visit on the theme of health, one of the main areas of work announced in his speech of April 17th. For Arnaud Chiche, resuscitator anesthesiologist, founder of the collective *Santé en danger*, the government must act as a priority on the lack of caregivers.

The health collective is asking for the abolition of administrative costs for doctors and an increase in salaries. It should also be noted that the prefecture of Loir et Cher has banned sound amplifiers for the arrival of Emmanuel Macron; so there will be no concert of pans and pots as planned by the CGT on the sidelines of the trip of the Head of State, under penalty of a fine.

The justice system suspends the destruction of a slum in Mayotte. It was to be demolished this morning as part of Operation Wuambushu, which aims to reduce illegal immigration in the French department of the Indian Ocean. Twenty inhabitants had lodged an appeal against this operation. The prefecture of Mayotte will appeal the decision and the Ministry of the Interior also confirms that the operation will continue and even intensify.

And then in the United States, the suspense may end today. US President Joe Biden could formalize his candidacy for the next presidential election in 2024 - Candidacy which may take form in a video.
